# Crazy Cat Woman Fights Animal Sanctuary Foreclosure With Tooth And Nail. Bankers Get What's Coming.

Cat rescue volunteer and all-time cat lover, Shelly Hayling, is beaming like the proverbial "Cheshire cat" after a stroke of unexpected good fortune came knocking at her Suffolk pet sanctuary door. Less than two weeks ago her home of 16 years, which she had converted into an animal rescue centre, was threatened with closure and repossession by the bank, after she struggled to make the mortgage repayments.

Since her husband of 21 years tragically died from a rare form of cancer, just over a year ago, she has been relying on donations from well-wishers and the goodwill of friends, to help keep the animal sanctuary up and running. However, the expenditure involved in feeding and homing 97 cats, 11 dogs, 14 rabbits and several other smaller animals far exceeded the very small income she was receiving from charitable contributions.

### Tried in vain to find homes for the animals...

Faced with closure she would have had to make arrangements for almost all of the animals to be put down, as other local animal rescue centres said they would be unable to accommodate the additional animals. Mrs Hayling had tried in vain to find homes for the animals but had only been able to find new homes for 8 of her younger cats. In a recent interview she said, "My worst nightmare was unfolding before me and there was absolutely nothing I could do."

She added, "I've always been an animal lover ever since I was a very young girl and cats have always been my favourite pet. I can't bear the thought of a cat going hungry or sleeping out in the cold so when I first found 2 emaciated stray cats wandering around outside my garden I took them in and looked after them. That was 19 years ago." She is well-known in the town of Stowmarket, Suffolk, where local residents refer to her as the "Crazy Cat Woman". "Crazy" because she's just crazy about cats, she admits. All had been going well until her husband, a Landscape Gardener, died after a short illness, and with no life insurance and a mountain of bills to pay she found herself in a very difficult financial situation. She had told friends that the sanctuary was her life and that running it had helped her to cope with the grief and despair of losing her husband.
